



RULES OF THE DOJANG

- 1. When seeing your Master or Instructor, you must bow. NEVER WAVE HELLO OR GOODBYE!**
- 2. Always address your Master or Instructor as “Sir” or “Ma’am”. NEVER ADDRESS THEM BY THEIR FIRST NAME!**
- 3. Do not face your Master or Instructor while fixing your uniform.**
- 4. Show respect to all senior belts.**
- 5. No profanity while in uniform.**
- 6. No chewing gum in the Dojang**
- 7. Never lose your temper while in uniform and ESPECIALLY in the Dojang**
- 8. Never lean on the walls, sit down, whistle, chew gum, or talk loudly in the Dojang**
- 9. Never leave class for water or early dismissal without permission from the Master or Instructor first**
- 10. Be on time for class**
- 11. Don’t let your mind wander while training – stay focused on your art.**
- 12. Do not talk or visit with anyone during class (unless asking for help) – stay focused.**
- 13. You must wear a clean and pressed uniform, keep your finger and toe nails cut short, and no jewelry should be worn during class.**
- 14. Students are not allowed to belong to any other Dojang.**
- 15. Remember never to misuse your “Art”. Following the rules of Martial Arts is what makes you a Martial Artist.**
